The Tractor Driver position is responsible for the safe operation of the tractor with the machine tree planter attachment for planting seedlings throughout the Kettle Creek watershed in addition to hand planting seedling and large stock trees. The position reports directly to the Forest and Soils Conservation Supervisor or the Stewardship Program Supervisor.

**Responsibilities:**

Candidate would be responsible for the safe operation of the tractor for machine planting tree and shrub seedlings.

Candidate would be responsible for conducting safety inspections and the maintenance of the tractor, machine planter and tree planting equipment, as well as the transportation of these materials to and from each planting site.

Candidate may assist with hand planting tree and shrub seedlings and large stock trees.

Perform other duties, which may be assigned by the Forest and Soils Conservation Supervisor or the Stewardship Program Supervisor.

Conduct work in a safe manner, ensuring KCCA's health and safety policies are adhered to at all times.

**Requirements:**

Proven experience with the safe operation of farm and/or landscape equipment.

Outdoor work experience in landscaping, farming, nursery operation, tree planting or forestry.

Good verbal communication and organizational skills.

Must be able to follow instructions and work with minimal supervision.

Available to work flexible hours as required including evenings and weekends.

Able to work as a team player.

Possess a valid Ontario Driver's License.
