

Tree Planter
Up to 5 weeks, \$17.56/hr

The Tree Planter position is responsible for the planting of seedlings and larger stock trees throughout the Kettle Creek watershed. The position reports directly to the Forest and Soils Conservation Supervisor or the Manager of Communications, Stewardship and Outreach.

Responsibilities:

- Unloading and sorting nursery stock
- Hand planting tree and shrub seedlings on lands throughout the watershed
- Planting large stock trees on lands throughout the watershed
- Machine planting tree and shrub seedlings on lands throughout the watershed
- Conduct work in a safe manner, ensuring KCCA's health and safety policies are adhered to at all times
- Other duties as assigned including but not limited to pruning trees and shrubs and maintaining hiking trails using manual and power tools

Requirements:

- Experience in landscaping, farming, nursery operation, tree planting or forestry.
- Must be able to follow instructions and work with minimal supervision.
- Must be willing to work outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Demonstrated ability to work as a team player.
- Possess a valid Ontario Class G2 or G Driver's License in good standing for the entirety of employment. Successful candidates must provide a MTO Driver's Abstract.
- CSA approved footwear must be worn at all times (to be supplied by the candidate)
- Possess a secondary school diploma.

The position is for up to 5 weeks with hours of work being Monday to Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
